The candidate should have a proven track record in Protein Biochemistry, a major focus of the University. The appointee is expected to contribute to and expand this area; applications from candidates who also research into applied aspects will be particularly well received. The post is extremely well equipped and in a stimulating environment, with ample opportunities for collaboration. Participation in existing interdisciplinary research programmes within and around Halle is welcomed, and interactions with local Biotechnology companies would be desirable.

Teaching duties include the training of students in Biochemistry and related disciplines in a Bachelor/Master framework, and the candidate is expected to represent the entire discipline. Candidates should possess a Ph. D. plus additional experience in research and teaching (corresponding to the German 'Habilitation'). Involvement in other academic and administrative duties within the University is also required.

The Martin-Luther-Universität Halle-Wittenberg strives to promote equal opportunities in science. Applications from female scientists are therefore strongly encouraged. Handicapped applicants, appropriately qualified according to the above criteria, will be given preference over other candidates with equivalent qualifications.

Applicants should submit a CV (including business and private addresses), copies of degree certificates, a list of publications, a short exposé of their scientific career, and a concise draft of teaching experiences as well as ongoing (including funding) and future research activities.
