Postdoctoral Fellow (13 TV-L, 100%) (f-m-n)

The position is **available immediately** and *limited to 2,5 years*, with the option for extension.

Requirements:

- Doctoral degree in the fields of life sciences (biochemistry, biology, medicine or related)
- Excellent experimental PhD thesis in the field of tumor biology/immunology
- Experience with laboratory animals (mice) including Felasa B certificate or equivalent
- Good/excellent command of English, both spoken and written
- First and/or last authorship in high-ranked, peer-reviewed scientific journals
- Innovative, independent and reliable work attitude paired with a high degree of motivation

Responsibilities:

- Characterizing the role of platelets in tumor growth and metastasis in solid tumors using in vitro and in vivo experiments including pre-clinical studies
- Participation in teaching activities offered by the research group
- Supervision of master and PhD students

An innovative and highly motivated environment awaits you as part of a Max-Eder junior research group supported by the German Cancer Aid with the aim of understanding the role of platelets and tumor-associated thrombocytosis. Own preliminary work has shown a significant impact of platelets on tumor growth and metastasis (JCI 2016; Nature Comm 2017; Blood 2017; MCT 2017; Cancer Cell 2018), which we would like to characterize further, thereby focusing on the regulation of the tumor immune microenvironment by platelets.
