- Characterizing of pro-tumorigenic and pro-metastatic signaling pathways in solid tumors focusing on the tumor microenvironment
- Identification of new target molecules for innovate cancer treatment
- Opportunity for further academic qualification (PhD) is given

- Master degree in the fields of life sciences (biochemistry, biology, or related)
