This is a permanent, full-time position, starting 1st December 2022. The salary will be commensurate with the qualifications of the successful candidate within the salary scale 13 TV-L

Responsibilities:

- Scientific curation, development and documentation of the paleontological, geological, mineralogical and Eocene Geiseltal fossil collections at the ZNS.
- Head of division at the ZNS; (co-)supervision of technical staff, guest scientists, work internships, etc.; main
 responsibility for scientific enquiries and scientific loans of division as well as revision of palaeontological
 and geological archive material.
- Scientific research on the collections of the ZNS and other collections including raising third-party-funds and regular publication of results in international journals as well as presentation at conferences.
- Participation in general curatorial and logistical tasks of the ZNS, cooperation in exhibition and public outreach projects; contributing to reports and catalogues of the ZNS as well as participation in the ZNS and university administration.
- Teaching participation at the Institute of Geosciences and Geography of the Martin Luther University Halle-Wittenberg (4 hours per week and semester).

Requirements:

- Master and PhD degree in geology or palaeontology or related disciplines.
- Expert knowledge in Eocene vertebrates as well as vertebrate anatomy, evolutionary biology and biometry, demonstrated by an excellent track record of peer-reviewed papers.
- Track record in the acquisition of funding.
- Experience in working with museum collections, collection inventories and documentation as well as collection care and logistics.
- Experience in developing material for exhibitions and communicating scientific research to a general audience.
- Excavation skills and practise in geological field as well as site documentations.
- Experiences in database management systems, digital statistics programs and digital reconstructions.
- Teaching experiences in basic geology and palaeontology.
- Being a good team player with excellent communication and interpersonal as well as organization skills for managing international research collaboration; own initiative and willingness for longer stays at other institutions in Germany and abroad.
