Prospective candidates need to demonstrate experience in theoretical and empirical analysis in the field of Educational Research covering areas of sociocultural change processes undertaken by young people in modern societies. Research and teaching responsibilities will focus on Socialisation Processes and Biographical Conditions in Social Contexts and Cultural Perception of young people. Questions toward social inequality and educational equity, a comparative research perspective towards the relation of formal, school and informal learning considering mediatisation of living conditions will determine the area of work as well as the consideration of cultural, legal and social conditions of modern childhood, youth and maturity with a view to promote educational processes. Teaching tasks will include responsibilities in BA and MA Educational Science Programmes as well as Teacher Preparation Programmes.

Prospective candidates need to have earned a PhD in Educational Sciences and to demonstrate scholarly work that best matches the focus of the call (e.g. "habilitation" or equivalent qualification are required). It is also expected that the Post holder contributes to increasing the research profile of the whole School and actively cooperates with the Centre for School and Education Research (ZSB).
