W3 Professor German Linguistics

(to succeed Prof. Dr. Gerd Antos)

The successful candidate will be expected to take up his/her duties on October 1st, 2015.

The person to be appointed will be expected to represent the faculty across the entire range of its research and teaching activities, with particular emphasis on contemporary German and applied linguistics. It would be desirable if the person to be appointed had undertaken research in the fields of discourse, textual or conversational linguistics and had the ability to apply these disciplines to the research fields of knowledge transfer such as understandability or legal linguistics.

In addition to participating in all the courses of study provided by the Germanic Institute the person to be appointed will be expected to participate in the activities of all departments, especially the German as a foreign language department, as well as to work collaboratively with the speech sciences department.

The post holder should have experience in acquiring funding for research as well as in collaborating with foreign partner universities.

In addition, the post holder's duties will include the requirements specified in section 34 of the Higher Education Act of the State of Saxony-Anhalt (teaching obligations, examination duties and additional pastoral responsibilities). Applicants must meet the conditions of employment specified in section 35 of the above Act. Applicants must hold a relevant postdoctoral lecturing qualification or equivalent academic qualifications and be able to demonstrate proof of pedagogical suitability.

The Martin Luther University of Halle-Wittenberg is committed to increasing the proportion of women among its academic staff and strongly encourages qualified women to apply. Where candidates are of equal suitability, preference will be given to severely disabled candidates. The Martin Luther University of Halle-Wittenberg offers excellent opportunities for combining professional and family life.

Remuneration will be in accordance with legal and budgetary requirements.
