Candidates with experience in translational research are particularly encouraged to apply. The successful candidate is expected to closely collaborate with researchers in clinical pharmacy, biochemistry and medical Pharmacology. Participation in interdisciplinary research programmes, especially on pharmaceutically relevant proteins, and in the establishment of new collaborative ventures is strongly encouraged.

Applicants should have a degree in Pharmacy, Medicine, Biochemistry, Chemistry or Biology, a doctoral degree in any of these disciplines, and additional scientific achievements. Teaching experience would be an advantage.

The candidates are expected to provide effective teaching in the entire field of Pharmacology for the Pharmacy and Natural Science programs. Active participation in academic and administrative duties within the university is expected according to Hochschulgesetz Sachsen-Anhalt (§ 34 HSG-LSA). Professors at the W1 level are offered an initial three-year contract. After a positive evaluation, the contract can be extended for a further three years. Upon a final positive evaluation, together with documentation that the other requirements of the post have been fulfilled, a tenured professorship position with the offered.
