



## **Information for applicants with international degrees**

Applicants with the following prerequisites should apply with the help of <https://my.uni-assist.de/>:

- school leaving certificate and/or university diploma obtained outside of Germany,
- FSP graduation from a Studienkolleg in Germany,
- school leaving certificate obtained at a German school abroad without Abiturprüfung,
- International Baccalaureate (IB) graduates.

Please note: **Citizens of the EU and the European Economic Area (EEA)** must submit their application for the 1<sup>st</sup> subject-semester for **Medicine, Dentistry or Pharmacy** exclusively to [www.hochschulstart.de](http://www.hochschulstart.de).

## **Application Deadlines**

- For bachelor, state examination and Studienkolleg/DSH:
  - winter semester: **15 July**
  - summer semester: **15 January** (Studienkolleg or DSH – 15 December recommended!)
- For master and LL.M:
  - winter semester: **15 June** (except MSc Pharmac. and Industrial Biotechnology: **31 March**)
  - summer semester: **15 December**

*The application portal will approx. be open from late September for summer semester and Mid-February for winter semester.*

## **Procedure**

- **Search** your desired programme or course in the course catalogue at <https://my.uni-assist.de/>
- **Register** for an account
- **Answer** the mandatory questions
- **Upload** your scanned documents
- **Pay the handling fees** and submit your application by the deadline

Halle University exclusively accepts online-only applications. Please upload scans of your original documents and – if necessary – certified translations into German or English with uni-assist completely and timely.

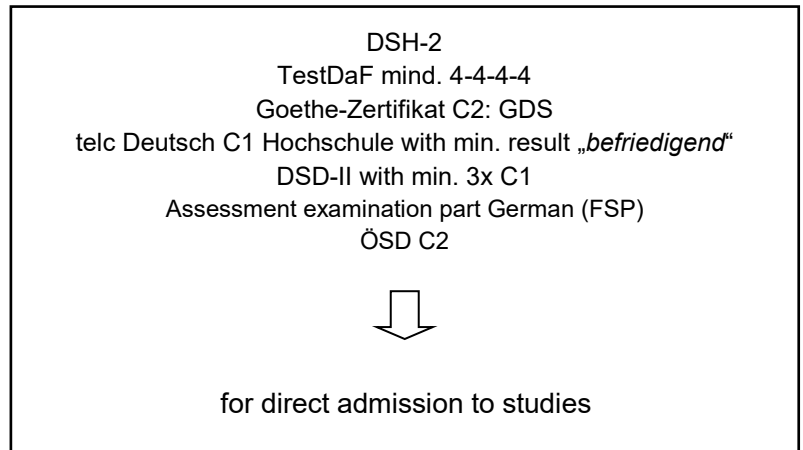
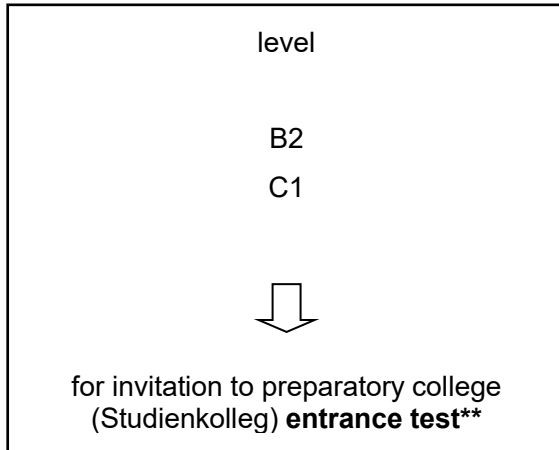
### Specific regulations

EU/EEA applicants for 1<sup>st</sup> semester to the undergraduate (Bachelor 180) **Biology, Biochemistry, Business Studies, Nutritional Sciences, Educational Sciences, Economics (VWL), Business Information Systems** and **Psychology** should register with [www.hochschulstart.de](http://www.hochschulstart.de) in order to receive so-called *BID/BAN-numbers* necessary for the application with uni-assist.

## Required Documents

- Complete school and university/college certificates: graduation certificate including course and grade overview (transcripts) in original language and – if necessary – official translations (German or English) as well as your university's official grading scheme
- Language certificate

for German speaking and bilingual programmes as follows:



- optional: if taken, please provide TestAS data to uni-assist

In the admission procedure for undergraduate programmes with Numerus clausus, a result of more than 80 percent in both the TestAS core and subject test leads to an improvement in the procedural grade of 0.2 points.

- other relevant proofs of subject-specific admission requirements f.e. entrance exam, motivation letter, language certificates (please checked study offer via <https://studienangebot.uni-halle.de/>)
