- > foreign school leaving / university certificates
- > graduation certificate from a German school without Abitur examination
- > International Baccalaureate (IB) graduates
- Studienkolleg FSP course graduation certificate from Germany

- > select your desired course / degree from the list of offers for the semester
- register on the website
- > answer the mandatory questions
- > upload all the necessary documents as a scan of the original to your account
- > pay the handling fee and submit your application

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS*

- > school leaving certificates / university graduation certificates and your university's official grading scheme
- > language certificates
- > if applicable:
 - > documents for subject-specific admission requirements
 - > TestAS (improve the admission grade when over 80% is scored in both tests - for undergraduate programmes)
 - country-specific documents (e.g. APS certificates for applicants from India, China, Vietnam, etc.)

Certified translations (from individuals or institutions authorised to make translations under oath or admissible in court) into German or English are only necessary if the documents are not issued in one of those languages.



EU/EEA applicants for 1st semester *Medicine*, *Dentistry*, or *Pharmacy* apply exclusively via www.hochschulstart.de.

EU/EEA applicants for 1st semester *B.Sc. Biology, Biochemistry, Business Administration, Nutritional Sciences, Educational Sciences, Economics, Business Information Systems and Psychology* register with www.hochschulstart.de to get a BID/BAN number and then apply via www.uni-assist.de.



LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Studienkolleg / DSH course

at least a B2 German language certificate German-taught degrees

- > DSH-2
- > TestDaF 4x4 points
- > Goethe C2
- > telc C1 (at least "befriedigend")
- > DSD-II (at least 3x C1)

bilingual / English-taught degrees

at least a B2 English language certificate
