Tasks:

- Participation and research in the current research program at the department related to sustainable natural resource use, agri-environmental governance, cooperative approaches in agricultural, environmental and food policy, commons governance and institutional analysis.
- Development of a suitable mixed methods approach of empirical social research methods to analyze socialagri-ecological systems.
- Support with research projects application and science management.
- Development of an independent research focus within the scope of the subject areas of the department and corresponding third-party funding.
