Research Assistant (post-doctoral position/ research assistantship) (m/f/d)

As full-time employment.

Remuneration will be up to the level of grade 13 TV-L, taking account of the tasks assigned and the applicant's personal qualifications required.

Tasks:

- Conducting own research project for academic qualification (PhD or Habilitation in your field of expertise)
- Conducting two seminars in German and English (4 hours a week) and advising and mentoring students
- Supervision and grading of seminar work
- Collaboration in the chair's academic projects
- Admin assistance for the departmental library
- Admin assistance of the department's website
- Assistance with maintaining the international contacts of the department
- Participation in departmental self-governance

Requirements:

- A Master of Divinity degree or equivalent in theology / for Post doc position: PhD in New Testament required
