Research Assistant (m/f/d)

as part-time employment (75 %).

The salary will be up to pay group 13 TV-L (according to the collective wage agreement of the German federal states), if the personal requirements and tasks are fulfilled.

Work tasks:

- Conducting a case study in the DFG-funded research project "Open geospatial data at the intersection of digital commoning, digital humanitarianism, and digital capitalism: Transformations and tensions in Open-StreetMap", which investigates the transformations and tensions in the field of open geodata, digital commons and volunteered geographic information in two case studies (more Information <u>https://digital.geo.uni-halle.de/2024/03/dfg-open-geospatial-data/</u>)
- Conducting field research (in the Philippines), data collection, analyses
- Collaboration with local and international project partners
- Publication of project results

The opportunity to obtain your own academic qualification as part of a doctorate is given.
